

Wardrobe Doors Repair Waiver

Wardrobe Door Repair – Waiver and Acknowledgment of Risk

Civic Shower Screens and Wardrobes has been requested to repair an existing wardrobe door. The door may have originally been manufactured by Civic or another supplier. While every care will be taken during the repair process, the condition, age and construction of existing doors mean repairs cannot be guaranteed.

Acknowledgment of Risks

By proceeding with this repair, I acknowledge and accept that:

- Civic cannot guarantee that the wardrobe door can be successfully repaired.
- Additional faults or damage may become apparent once the door is dismantled.
- If the door is found to be beyond repair or unsuitable for repair, a minimum assessment and labour charge of \$50 will apply, even if no repair is completed.
- Civic reserves the right to refuse repairs where the product is unsafe, incompatible, or beyond economical repair.

Warranty Disclaimer

Where a repair is completed:

- Civic's warranty applies only to the workmanship and any components replaced by Civic during the repair.
- No warranty is provided for existing frames, rollers, tracks, guides, handles, or any other original components that have not been replaced.
- Civic accepts no responsibility for the future performance or compatibility of wardrobe doors that were not originally manufactured by Civic.
